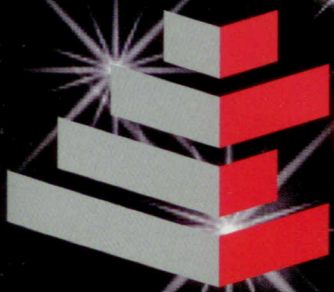

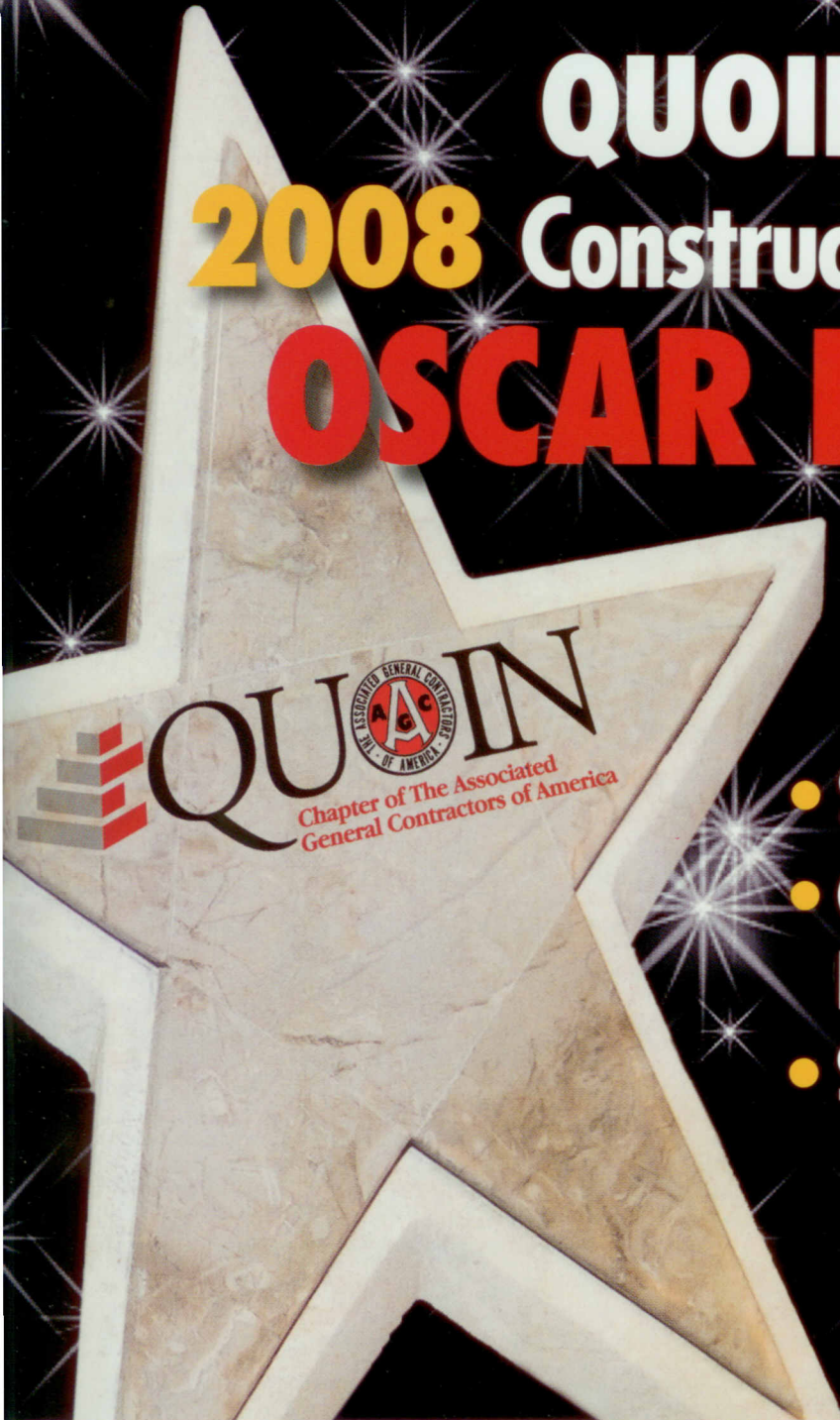

# Carrco Painting Contractors, Inc.

## Adding the color to a unique family resort



**G**rapevine's Great Wolf Lodge provides its guests with a full-service resort experience. In addition to the more traditional vacation amenities like suites, restaurants, spas and arcades, Great Wolf brings the outdoors in, with its unique 80,000-square-foot, indoor water park. Carrco Painting Contractors was charged with the task of adding the color to this fun-loving facility. For exceeding the expectations of the owner and the general contractor, Carrco has received a 2008 Summit Award, for specialty painting projects.

At 450,000 square feet, this facility required a lot of paint and wall coverings. The original scope of the project called for just interior painting and wall covering. But, after seeing the siding color change with the sun's reflection, Carrco was called upon to paint

the exterior siding, as well. In fact, 44,000 square feet of Country Red Heritage shingles were covered with one coat of Val-sparR0056. To accommodate the owners, the Carrco team varied from their usual technique; instead of rolling on the paint and brushing it out, they deviated from the norm and brushed this whole job. After one week to prepare the surface, a crew of 14—using seven boom lifts at heights of 125 and 135 feet—completed this massive effort in an impressively compact two weeks. This impressively short timeframe was significant because once the painting was complete and the cleanup was finished the landscapers needed to get started on their work.

In recognition of Carrco's extra effort and flexibility on the Great Wolf Lodge project, the general contractor, Turner Construction Company, presented the team with a Turner Outstanding Performance Award.
